

Steps to Retrieving Information Documents for

Nursing Home Citation N0433, (s. 400.191(5)(a)2, F.S.) Requirements

1. Start at FloridaHealthFinder.gov
2. Under the section [Locate](#), click [Facilities or Providers](#)
3. On the Facility/Provider Locator page, click [Search by Facility Type/Location](#)
4. On the Facility/Provider Locator General Search page, select in the Facility/Provider Type selection—[Nursing Home](#) and enter the [Facility Name](#) in the Name selection; click the Search button
5. On the Facility/Provider Search Results page, click the name of the Facility you've just searched for; the Provider's Facility Profile page is displayed

6. Print the Facility Profile page

7. On the Facility Profile page, under the AHCA Reports section, check to see if there is Watch List Information. If there is, click on [Watch List Information](#) and **Print the Watch List Information page**. To return to the Facility Profile page, click [Back to Facility Profile](#)
8. On the Facility Profile page, under the Compare Quality and /or Pricing section, click [Nursing Home Guide](#); this will automatically transfer the provider/consumer to [the Facility's Nursing Home Inspection Ratings page](#)

9. Print the Nursing Home Inspection Ratings page

10. Note the [Rating Time Period in the header](#) then click on the I (information) in the Facility / City field next to the City name—the information displayed are all of the deficiencies that the facility has received for many years

11. Print off the pages of deficiencies that would only encompass the Rating Time Period
