❑ Data Dissemination and Communications - *Trish Vidal, Manager*

FloridaHealthFinder

- Visits year to date: 1,915,242 (Visits increased a 0.2% more than previous year by this month). They also increased for the past two months (July and August), with 12.75%, compared to last year
- Webinars completed by the Outreach Coordinator: 45 webinars for 838 attendees
- Updates:
 - Hospitals – the *Acute Stroke Ready Center* has been added to the advanced search option
 - Health Care Clinic Exemption – top right of the profile page now displays *owner and expiration date*
 - Clinical Labs – *Waived/Non-Waived* is now displayed under *Services/Characteristics* as they no longer require state licensure and will now behave like federal clients
 - Home Health Agency Exemption - has been added to the website and *Services Provided* data displays under the services and characteristics option
 - Providers with license status 'Applicant in Process' will be displayed as closed providers as they previously held a license and failed to renew
 - Tableau will be incorporated to FloridaHealthFinder as a new query tool system

Pediatric Cardiology Technical Advisory Panel for Florida

- The PCTAP Panel continues to work on developing procedures and standards for measuring outcomes of pediatric cardiac catheterization and surgery programs; the Panel has had 20 Webinars to date with a total of 264 Attendees

- Nearly 3,000 adverse incidents submitted to date
- The agency held a rule workshop on August 24, 2018 regarding the annual reporting form for Hospitals, ASCs, and HMOs
- Will soon publish proposed rule for 59A-10.002
 - the definition rule for the Internal Risk Management Program
 - Agency is revising this rule following the implementation of SB 622: Health Care Facility Regulation
- Nearly 700 annual reports submitted for the current reporting year
- Currently in the testing phase for a new Liability Claims reporting system (ALFs are required to submit these reports when there is a claim against the facility)

- Encounter Notification Service
 - 95% of Acute Care Beds
 - Subscribers receive alerts on over 8 million patients
 - Subscribers include:
 - 5 health systems (inclusive of over 50 hospitals)
 - 27 provider groups
 - 13 Community Health Centers & 14 other primary care and specialty practices
 - 22 Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs)
 - 14 health plans (including all Medicaid Managed Care plans)
 - Seeking LTPAC connectivity
- Collaboration with the Department of Health, including:
 - County Health Departments
 - Syndromic Surveillance
 - emPower

EHR Incentive Program

- Currently processing 2017 applications
- Stage 3 Meaningful Use - Mandatory in 2019

Data Collection Certification

Data Collection certification for 1st Quarter 2018 closed on September 5 without any delinquencies.

This is the first quarter in which facilities with multiple off-site ED included services for each location, pursuant to rule 59E-7, F.A.C.

Discharge Data Collection and Modernization Planning

ISF completed their contract with AHCA for the data collection modernization plan. The final recommendation included 3 options to achieve the ideal state:

- Total outsourcing data collection
- custom in-house built system
- combination of the two

Agency is currently considering the option for the combination of the two solutions. This will allow for Agency control of the process, maintaining continuity without rule changes, while improving the submission process.
