Florida HIE Services

- Encounter Notification Service (ENS)
 - 95% of Acute Care Beds
 - Subscribers receive alerts on over 8 million patients
 - Subscribers include:
 - 5 health systems (inclusive of over 50 hospitals)
 - 37 provider groups
 - 16 Federally Qualified Health Centers
 - 21 other primary care and specialty practices
 - 23 Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs)
 - 13 health plans (including all Medicaid Managed Care plans)
 - Seeking LTPAC connectivity
- Collaboration with the Florida Department of Health, including:
 - County Health Departments
 - Syndromic Surveillance
 - emPower
