Adjunctive General Services	Additional dental services including dental consultations and help with minor dental pain	✓	✓*
Dental Exams	A review of your tooth, teeth, or mouth by a dentist	✓	✓*
Dental Screenings	A review of your mouth by a dental hygienist	✓	✓*
Dental X-rays	Internal pictures of teeth with different views	✓	✓*
Diabetic Testing	Dental office diabetic testing (HbA1c) for patients with diabetes or at risk of being diabetic	✓	✓*
Extractions	Tooth removal	✓	✓
Fillings	A dental service to fix or repair teeth	✓	✓*
Crowns	A dental service to fix or repair teeth a filling cannot correct	✓	
Fluoride	A medicine put on teeth to make them stronger	✓	✓*
Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery	Surgery and treatment of diseases, injuries, and defects to the oral and maxillofacial regions	✓	✓*
Oral Health Instructions	Education on how to brush, floss, and keep your teeth healthy	✓	✓*
Orthodontics	Braces or other ways to correct teeth location	✓	
Periodontics	Deep cleanings that may involve both your teeth and gums	✓	✓*
Practice Acclimation for Persons with Intellectual Disabilities	Visits for adults with disabilities to become comfortable with the dental office and provider before any dental services are provided	✓	✓*
Prosthodontics	Dentures or other types of objects to replace teeth	✓	✓
Root Canals	A dental service to fix the inside part of a tooth (nerve)	✓	
Sealants	Thin, plastic coatings painted into the grooves of teeth to help prevent cavities	✓	✓*
Sedation	A way to provide dental services where a patient is asleep or partially asleep	✓	✓
Space Maintainers	A way to keep space in the mouth when a tooth is taken out or missing	✓	
Teeth Cleanings	Basic cleanings that may include brushing, flossing, scrubbing, and polishing teeth	✓	✓*
